

For General Volunteers:

- Listen to and follow the directions of your STATE AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES. IF YOU FEEL SICK, stay home. Do not go to drive. Contact your medical provider.
- IF YOUR CHILDREN ARE SICK, keep them at home. Stay with them and please do not drive. Contact your medical provider.
- IF SOMEONE IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD HAS TESTED POSITIVE for the coronavirus, keep the entire household at home. Do not drive. Contact your medical provider.
- IF YOU ARE A PERSON WITH A SERIOUS UNDERLYING HEALTH CONDITION or are potentially at greater risk according to CDC, we ask that you please consider your health before volunteering.

For Drivers and Their Vehicles:

- Between rides please wait for your passenger to leave or pull over to a safe place and wipe down seatbelt fasteners, door handles, door pockets, the backseat and the back of the front passenger headboard.
- Drive with the rear window down when you have a passenger in the car, and please keep it down for the duration of your ride. It's unfortunate but it does help.
- Bi-weekly, drivers will sterilize their cars at special locations. Sterilization will be free of cost as long as you have your Rubi Badge. If you do not have your Rubi Badge, then you may be charged or not serviced at all, depending on availability. This service for our team is brought to you by the premier car care service in our area, Kangaroo.
- Make sure passengers have taken all of their belongings out of the car.
- Do not help put anything in the trunk, but make sure the trunk is open for passengers to use. If a passenger uses your trunk, be sure to disinfect or notify our sterilization crew to focus attention there.

How to Care for N95 Masks:

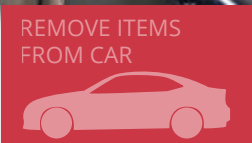
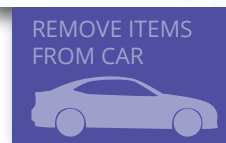
- Make sure you have on a 2nd clean mask over your Rubi Mask. This can be a bandana, scarf, etc.
- BEFORE PUTTING ON OR TAKING OFF YOUR MASK: WASH YOUR HANDS!!!! If possible, handle the mask with sterile gloves.
- Avoid touching the inside of the mask.
- The masks are very fragile. Please take extreme care in handling them, the straps break easily, and the seal can wear with misuse. So please handle with care.
- At the end of everyday, spray a little bit of Lysol on the front of your mask to disinfect the masks and let it sit in a clean, safe place when not in use.
- Keep your mask away from any pets!
- Again, because it's very important, the masks are delicate, so please handle with care!

For Riders:

- ALL RIDERS NEED TO HAVE MASKS ON DURING THE ENTIRE DURATION OF THE RIDE. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- As a safety precaution, windows will remain partially open for the duration of the ride. We sincerely apologize for the inconvenience this may cause.
- Make sure you take ALL OF YOUR BELONGINGS out of the vehicle. Lost and found options will be limited.

WATCH FOR SYMPTOMS:

- Reported illnesses have ranged from mild symptoms to severe illness and death for confirmed coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) cases.
- These symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure (based on the incubation period of MERS-CoV viruses).
 - Fever
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath
 - Loss of taste and smell
- Under no circumstance should you be driving/riding if you have any of these conditions. Take the needed steps to protect yourself and others. AND REMEMBER: ALWAYS WASH YOUR HANDS and PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING!
